

<u>Lindale ISD Employee/Workplace Process Map for COVID-19</u>

To be considered exposed to COVID-19, you need to have prolonged close contact with a person who has the virus. Close contact includes living in the same household, caring for a sick person with the virus, being within 6 feet of a sick person with the virus for at least 15 continuous minutes without the use of a face covering, or being in direct contact with secretions from the sick person.

Scenario C – Employee reports someone at home has symptoms OR someone at home has tested positive

Employee contacts supervisor.
Supervisor contacts Administration
for guidance when employee may
return to work

Employee should contact their primary care physician, self-isolate for 14 days. Employee should monitor for symptoms and contact primary care physician if they develop. (May return sooner with negative test result and written medical clearance)
